## SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET NO. 4 - FISCAL YEAR 1989

March 17, 1988

Mr. President, Mr. Speaker, Ladies
and Gentlemen of the General Assembly:

Pursuant to the authority conferred on me by Article III, Section 52, Subsection (5) of the <u>Constitution of Maryland</u>, and in accordance with the consent of the (State Senate) - (House of Delegates), duly granted, I hereby submit a supplement to Senate Bill 270 and/or House Bill 375 in the form of an amendment to the original budget for the Fiscal Year ending June 30, 1989.
