CHAPTER 122

(Senate Bill 145)

AN ACT concerning

Criminal Justice Information System

FOR the purpose of altering certain provisions of law relating to the criminal justice information system; eliminating certain data elements not considered to be criminal history record information; altering the definition of criminal justice agency; providing that a designee of the Criminal Justice Information Advisory Board may vote; establishing a quorum for the transaction of business; altering the membership of the Criminal Justice Information Advisory Board; altering references to the Governor's Commission on Law Enforcement and the Administration of Justice to be the Governor's Office of Justice Assistance; altering the administration and operation of the central repository; eliminating an obsolete duty of the Maryland State Police to collect and disseminate criminal record information; and generally relating to criminal history record information and the criminal justice information system.
