

REPORT WHICH INCLUDES RECOMMENDATIONS AS TO HOW VICTIM ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS MAY BE IMPROVED;

(6) ENSURE THAT THE RIGHTS OF VICTIMS ARE OBSERVED AND ASSIST VICTIMS IN ATTAINING THE INFORMATION TO WHICH VICTIMS HAVE A RIGHT; AND

(7) MONITOR COMPLIANCE WITH THE GUIDELINES FOR TREATMENT OF AND ASSISTANCE TO VICTIMS AND WITNESSES SET UNDER ARTICLE 27, § 761 OF THE CODE AND SUCH OTHER GUIDELINES FOR TREATMENT OF VICTIMS OF CRIMES AND OFFENSES AS MAY BE ADOPTED IN THE FUTURE.

THE VICTIM SERVICES COORDINATOR SHALL RECEIVE AN ANNUAL SALARY AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the terms of membership of the 10 appointed members of the State Board of Victim Services shall begin on July 1, 1988 as follows:

- (1) 2 members shall be appointed for a term of 5 years;
- (2) 2 members shall be appointed for a term of 4 years;
- (3) 3 members shall be appointed for a term of 3 years; and
- (4) 3 members shall be appointed for a term of 2 years.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1988.
