- (A) THE SECRETARY SHALL DETERMINE WHETHER THE RECEIVERSHIP BE FUNDED BY STATE FUNDS PREVIOUSLY DESIGNATED FOR THE COMMUNITY RESIDENTIAL PROGRAM. EVENT IN THE THAT PREVIOUSLY DESIGNATED FUNDS ARE AVAILABLE, THESE FUNDS SHALL BE USED FOR THE OPERATION OF THE RECEIVERSHIP.
