(b) With respect to emergency admissions, the Department shall be subrogated against any insurance coverage available to the patient for charges relating to THE emergency ROOM service, initial consultant examination by a {physician,} PSYCHIATRIST, and transportation to an emergency facility under Part IV of this subtitle.
