

(a) On or before January 1 of each year, the Secretary shall report to the General Assembly, in accordance with § 2-1312 of the State Government Article, on the complaint system established under § 19-705.2 of the Health - General Article.

(b) The report shall include:

~~(1) The total number and nature of complaints received concerning the operation of all health maintenance organizations in this State;~~

~~(2) The total number and nature of complaints received concerning the operation of each health maintenance organization in this State; and~~

~~(3) Any action taken by the Secretary or the Commissioner against a health maintenance organization operating in this State and a statement whether the action taken was initiated as a result of a complaint received in accordance with the provisions of § 19-705.2 of the Health - General Article; an analysis and evaluation of how the complaint system is working and identify any areas of concern relating to the operation of health maintenance organizations in this State.~~

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1988.
