VETOES

(C) THE STATE BOARD FOR HIGHER EDUCATION SHALL REPORT ANNUALLY TO THE LEGISLATIVE POLICY COMMITTEE ON THE TOTAL NUMBER OF PARTICIPANTS IN THE TUITION REDUCTION PROGRAM AND THE STATUS OF GRADUATES WITH AN OUTSTANDING OBLIGATION FOR WORK WITHIN THE STATE OR REPAYMENT OF TUITION REDUCTION UNDER THIS SECTION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1988.
