f-(d) An individual may not be transported to or from any facility unless accompanied by:

(1) An individual who is authorized by the facility and is of the same sex. HOWEVER, THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER OF THE FACILITY OR THAT OFFICER'S DESIGNEE MAY DESIGNATE A PERSON OF EITHER SEX TO PROVIDE TRANSPORTATION TO AN INDIVIDUAL, IF DEEMED APPROPRIATE; or
