Article 48 - Inspections

There is hereby created within the Division of Labor and Industry a Board of Boiler Rules, referred to hereafter as the "Board," consisting of seven members, which shall be appointed by the Governor with the advice of the Secretary of Licensing and Regulation, and with the advice and consent of the Senate. Among the members of the Board shall be one representative of the owners and users of power boilers, one representative of owners and users of heating boilers, one representative of owners and users of pressure vessels, one representative of manufacturers or assemblers of boilers or pressure vessels, one representative of
