E. All of the inmates will have served at least 50% of their total sentence by December 25, 1988;

F. None of these inmates have been refused parole;

G. None of these inmates have a record of significant disciplinary adjustment;

H. Assurances have been received that each of the inmates listed in this Executive Order can be released without danger to the public safety; and

WHEREAS, Having carefully considered the recommendations of the local authorities and the Maryland Parole Commission which have been made to me;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, WILLIAM DONALD SCHAEFER, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND, HAVING THOUGHT PROPER THE EXTENSION OF CLEMENCY, DO HEREBY, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME BY LAW, GRANT UNTO THE PERSONS LISTED IN THIS EXECUTIVE ORDER A COMMUTATION FOR THE REMAINDER OF THEIR SENTENCES AS IMPOSED FOR THE OFFENSES INDICATED:

AND I HEREBY Direct the release from further confinement of the aforesaid individuals no later than December 24, 1988 or within a reasonable time thereafter if subject to additional legal process. I do hereby further direct that the commutation described herein is subject to supervision of the persons listed in this Executive Order by the Division of Parole and Probation, upon the same terms and conditions as if on parole. I do further direct that these commutations are subject to the fulfillment of the special conditions recommended for each inmate, if any, by the Maryland Parole Commission and as listed in this Executive Order.
