THE STATE OR OF A COUNTY OR MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE STATE; AND

(II) COMPLETED SUCCESSFULLY THE TRAINING CERTIFIED BY THE POLICE TRAINING COMMISSION OR THE MARYLAND FIRE-RESCUE EDUCATION AND TRAINING COMMISSION.

13-304. APPLICATION FOR LICENSE.

(A) IN GENERAL.

- (1) AN APPLICANT FOR A LICENSE SHALL:
- (I) SUBMIT TO THE SUPERINTENDENT AN APPLICATION ON THE FORM THAT THE SUPERINTENDENT PROVIDES;
- (II) SUBMIT THE DOCUMENTS REQUIRED UNDER THIS SECTION; AND
- (III) PAY TO THE SUPERINTENDENT THE FEES REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION.
- (2) IF THE APPLICANT IS A FIRM, THE REPRESENTATIVE MEMBER SHALL COMPLETE THE APPLICATION FORM AND OTHERWISE BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE FIRM'S COMPLIANCE WITH THIS SECTION.
 - (B) FEES.
- (1) AN APPLICANT FOR A LICENSE SHALL PAY TO THE SUPERINTENDENT AN APPLICATION FEE OF:
 - (I) \$400, IF THE APPLICANT IS AN INDIVIDUAL; OR
