In paragraph (2) of this subsection, the phrase "responsible engineering teaching" is retained even though it is not defined in this title and its meaning is not otherwise apparent. The Business Occupations Article Review Committee retained the phrase on the understanding that it is a term of art within the engineering profession.

14-102. LEGISLATIVE POLICY.

THE PURPOSES OF THIS TITLE ARE TO SAFEGUARD LIFE, HEALTH, AND PROPERTY AND TO PROMOTE THE PUBLIC WELFARE BY REGULATING PERSONS WHO PRACTICE ENGINEERING IN THE STATE.

The express reference to regulation of "persons who practice engineering in the State" is added for clarity.

THERE IS A STATE BOARD FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERS IN THE DEPARTMENT.
