- (4) (5) (4) REPORTING RECOMMENDATIONS ON COMPLEMENTARY MEDICAL METHODS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SECTION.
- (D) THE MEMBERS OF THE COMMISSION SHALL SELECT A CHAIRPERSON FROM THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE COMMISSION.
 - (E) MEMBERS OF THE COMMISSION SHALL SERVE WITHOUT COMPENSATION.
- (F) . THE COMMISSION SHALL REPORT ITS FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE GOVERNOR AND, SUBJECT TO § 2–1312 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY BY JULY DECEMBER 1, 1994 AND THEREAFTER TERMINATE ITS EXISTENCE.
- (G) STAFF FOR THE COMMISSION SHALL BE PROVIDED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE.
