SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

**Article – Health Occupations**

19–305.1.

Until [July 1, 1993] ~~OCTOBER 1, 1995~~ JANUARY 1, 1995, the Board shall waive the examination requirements of this title for an applicant for a certified social worker–clinical license if the applicant:

- (1) Pays the application fee required by the Board under § 19–303 of this subtitle;
- (2) ~~Is~~ WAS a licensed certified social worker ON JULY 1, 1993; and
- (3) ~~Is~~ WAS eligible for inclusion on the vendorship list maintained by the Board ON JULY 1, 1993.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, has been passed by a ye and nay vote supported by three–fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is enacted.

**CHAPTER 90**

**(House Bill 366)**

AN ACT concerning

**Cecil County – Fee for Trader’s License**
