

- (10) September 12, for Defenders' Day;
- (11) October 12, for Columbus Day, unless the United States Congress designates another day for observance of that legal holiday, in which case, the day designated by the United States Congress;
- (12) November 11, for Veterans' Day;
- (13) The fourth Thursday in November, for Thanksgiving Day;
- (14) December 25, for Christmas Day;
- (15) Each statewide general election day in this State; and
- (16) Each other day that the President of the United States or the Governor designates for general cessation of business.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1994.
