(H) ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 31, 1995, THE COMMISSION SHALL SUBMIT ITS FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE ~~SENATE JUDICIAL PROCEEDINGS COMMITTEE AND THE HOUSE JUDICIARY COMMITTEE OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY~~ GOVERNOR FOR FURTHER ACTION.

(I) THIS SECTION SHALL TERMINATE AND BE OF NO EFFECT AFTER DECEMBER 31, 1995.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1994.
