SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND; That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Labor and Employment

9-1106.

(a) ~~(1) A person may not knowingly obtain or knowingly attempt to obtain compensation to which the person is not entitled.~~

~~(2) A PERSON MAY NOT KNOWINGLY AFFECT OR KNOWINGLY ATTEMPT TO AFFECT THE PAYMENT OF COMPENSATION, FEES, OR EXPENSES UNDER THIS TITLE BY MEANS OF A FALSE OR FRAUDULENT REPRESENTATION.~~

(b) A person who violates this section, on conviction:

(1) is subject to the penalties under Article 27, § 342 of the Code; and

(2) may not receive compensation, FEES, OR EXPENSES UNDER THIS TITLE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1994.
