The condition of the above obligation is such that if the above bounden Isaac Sumner shall well & faithfully execute the office of Constable in 1106 election district is Worcester County in all things appertaining thereto and shall also well and truly account for all monies placed in his hands for collection and shall also well & truly pay all sums of money received by him agreeably to an act of the general assembly passed at November session Eighteen hundred & nine entitled an "act relating to Constables bonds" and shall well & truly account for all money which he shall receive on judgments and shall well & truly pay over the same and shall faithfully perform all acts which he shall perform in virtue of his office in the said County in the state of Maryland then the above obligation to be void else to remain in full force and virtue -
