 that if the above bounden William R. Fall shall well and truly execute the office  
 of Constable of Election District number four in all things appertaining thereto  
 and shall also well and truly account for all monies placed in his hands  
 for collection and shall also well and truly pay all sums of money received  
 by him then the above obligation to be void otherwise to be of full force and virtue  
 in law
