just sum of Two thousand Dollars current money of the United States to be
paid to the said State or its certain attorney, to the which payment, well and
truly to be made and done, we bind ourselves our heirs, executors & administrators
to wit, jointly and severally, firmly by these presents, sealed with our seals and
dated this 17 day of April 1843. The condition of the above obligation is such
that if the above bounden Josiah Layton shall well and truly execute
the office of Constable of Election District no 3, in all things appertaining
thereto, & shall also well and truly account for all moneys placed in his
hands for collection, and shall also well and truly pay all sums of money
received by him, then the obligation to be void, otherwise, of full force and
virtue in law
