Girl Slave called Phobe aged about twelve years, and being desirous to remove
and bring the said Negro Slave called Phobe from the State of Delaware within
this State, for my own use and benefit and not for sale, do make out this
Certificate of the Negro Girl called Phobe, agreeably to the act of Assembly in
