 firmly by these presents - Sealed with our seals and dated this 15th day
 of April 1844. Whereas the Commissioners of Dorchester County, by virtue
 of a supplement to the act entitled an additional supplement to
 the act entitled an act to regulate Ferries, have contracted with the
 said Levin J. Dunnock & Thomas Wilson to keep the Ferry over Slaughter
 Creek from Taylor's Island to Minkins' neck, and agree to allow the said
 Levin J. Dunnock and Thomas Wilson the sum of one hundred and fifty
 dollars current money for the same - Now the condition of the above
 obligation is such that if the above bounden Levin J. Dunnock and
 Thomas Wilson shall faithfully and diligently keep the said Ferry over
 Slaughter Creek from Taylor's Island to Minkins' neck, from day light
 to day light from the first of November to the first of March, and for
 an hour before to an hour after day light for the residue of the year
 commencing 10th May 1844 and ending twelve months thereafter, and
 shall keep constantly and in good order a scow that will safely carry
 three passengers and their Horses at one trip, with an able bodied and
 skilful hand to attend the said Ferry, and shall not charge or receive
 any greater price for ferryage than what is allowed by law, then the
 above obligation to be void, otherwise of force.
