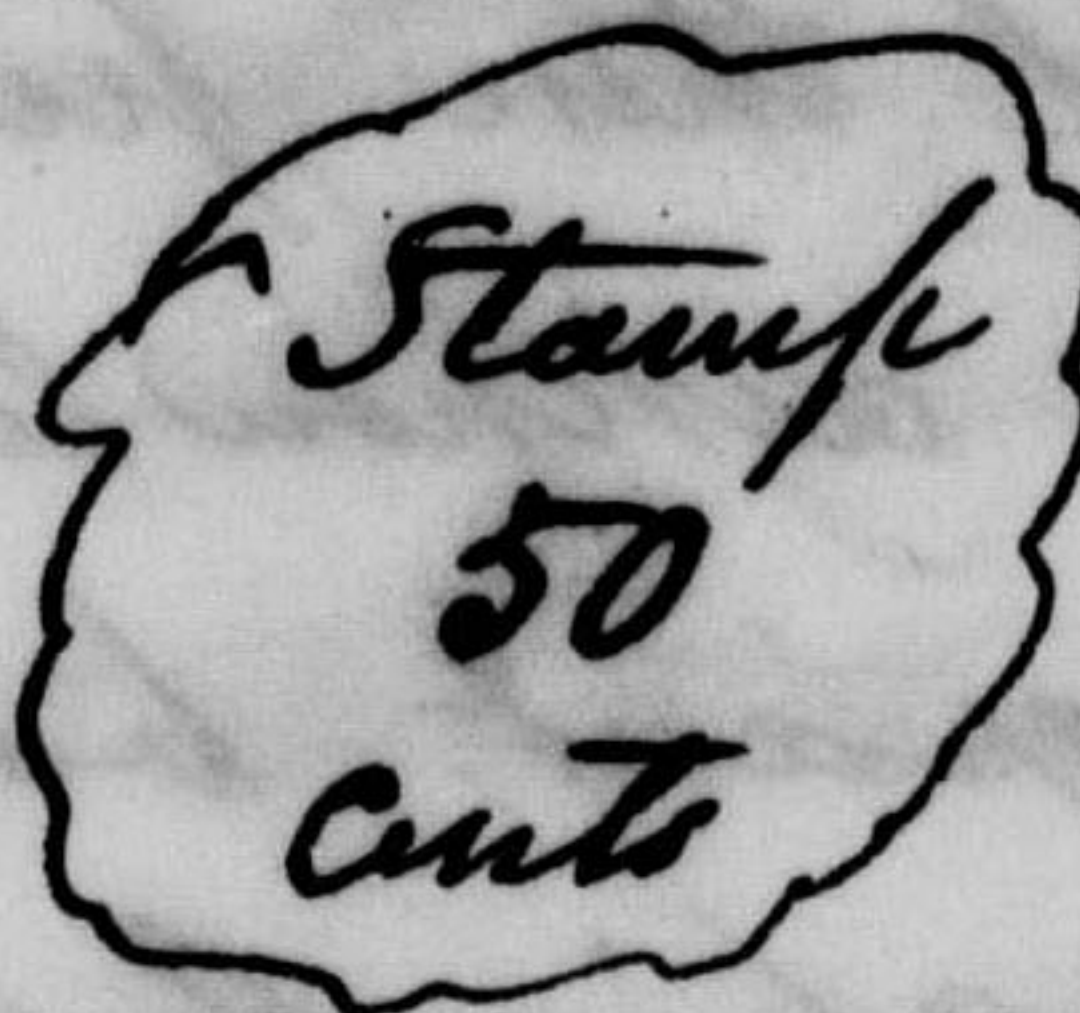

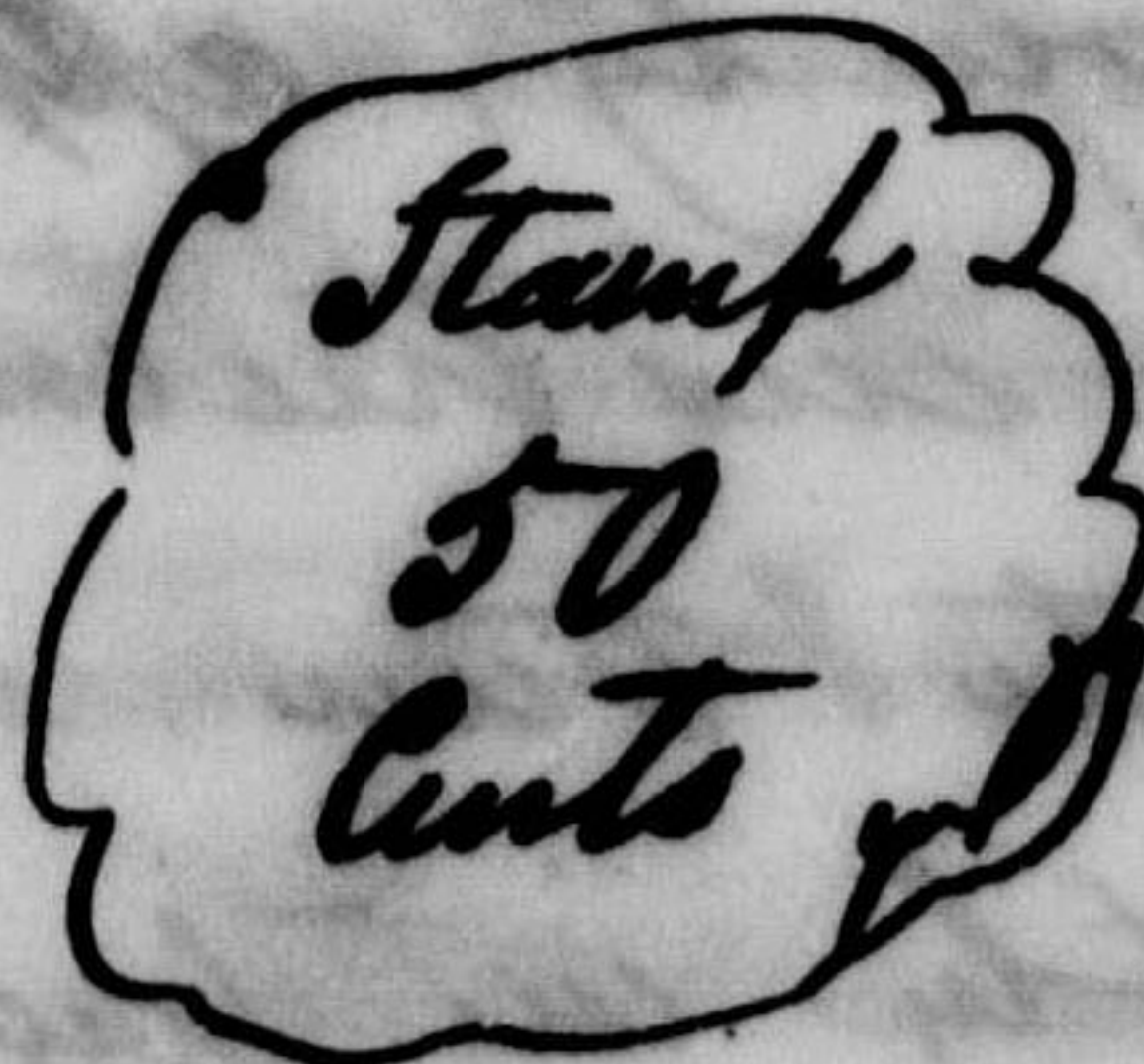

Wm B. Dail & } Know all men by these presents that we William
Geo. W. Wingate } B. Dail & George W. Wingate, of Dorchester County
in the State of Maryland, are held and firmly bound unto the State of Maryland in the full and just sum of Seven hundred and thirty four dollars and sixty six cents, current money of the United States, to be paid to the said State or its certain Attorney, to the which payment well and truly to be made and done, we bind ourselves and each of us, our and each of our heirs, executors and administrators, jointly and severally, firmly by these presents. Sealed with our seals & dated this ninth day of June in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and forty five. The Condition of the above obligation is such that if the above bounden William B. Dail, appointed Collector for Dorchester County, shall faithfully collect and pay the sum of Three hundred and sixty four dollars and thirty three cents, current money of the United States, into the Treasury of the State of Maryland, on or before the first day of July, in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and forty six, to and for the use of the State, then the above obligation to be void, or else to be and remain in full force & virtue in Law.
