The Condition of the above Obligation is such that if the above bounden Hendal M. Jacobs, appointed Collector of the Direct Tax, under the Act of the Legislature of the State of Maryland passed the 10<sup>th</sup> day of March 1842 Chapter 325, shall well and faithfully perform the duties required of him as Collector by the Act aforesaid, or by law, then the above obligation to be void, or else to be and remain in full force and virtue in law.
