cents, current money of the United States, to be paid to the said
State or its certain Attorney, to the which payment well and truly
to be made and done, we bind ourselves and each of us, our
and each of our heirs, Executors and Administrators, jointly &
severally, firmly by these presents. Sealed with our seals and
dated this tenth day of June in the year of our Lord Eighteen
hundred and forty six - The Condition of the above
Obligation is such that if the above bounden Kendal M.
Jacobs, appointed Collector of Dorchester County, shall well and
faithfully execute his office, and the several duties required of
him by law, and shall well and truly account for and pay
to the Commissioners of Dorchester County, or to their order, the
several sums of money which he shall receive or be answerable
for by law, at such time as the law shall direct, then the
within Obligation to be void, or else to be and remain in full
force and virtue in law.
