Smith shall well and truly execute the Office of Constable, in Election District number two, in Dorchester County, in all things appertaining thereto, and shall well and truly account for all monies placed in his hands for Collection, and shall also well and truly pay all sums of Money claimed by him, then the above obligation to be void, otherwise of full force and virtue in Law.
