Hicks, Turpin Wright and Levin Mobray, of Dorchester County in the State of Maryland, are held and firmly bound unto the State of Maryland, in the full and just sum of Thirty one thousand seven hundred and seventy one dollars and forty eight Cents, Current Money of the United States, to be paid to the said State or its certain Attorney, to the which payment well and truly to be made and done, we bind ourselves and each of us, our heirs and assigns, Executors and Administrators, jointly and severally, firmly by these presents. Sealed with our seals and dated this sixteenth day of June in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and forty seven.

The Condition of the above obligation is such that if the above bounden Kendall M. Jacobs, appointed Collector of Dorchester County, shall well and faithfully execute his office, and the several duties required of him by law, and shall well and truly account for and pay to the Commissioners for Dorchester County, or to their order, the several sums of Money which he shall receive, or be answerable for by law, at such time as the law shall direct, then the above obligation to be void, or else to be and remain in full force and virtue in law.
