 shall faithfully collect and pay the sum of three hundred & sixty  
 seven dollars and thirty three cents, current money, of the United  
 States, into the Treasury of the State of Maryland, on or before the  
 first day of July in the year of Our Lord Eighteen hundred &  
 forty nine, to and for the use of the State, then the above Obligation
