Sealed with our seals and dated this sixteenth day of June in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and forty seven. — The Condition of the above obligation is such that if the above bounden Mendal M. Jacobs, appointed Collector of the Direct Tax for Dorchester County, shall well and faithfully execute the office of Collector of the Direct Tax for said County, and the several duties required of him by Law, and shall well and truly account for and pay to the Treasurer of Maryland the several sums of money which he shall receive or be answerable for by Law, at such time as the Law shall direct, then the above obligation to be void, or else to be and remain in full force and virtue in Law.
