Elliott shall well & truly execute the Office of Constable in Election District Number four in Dorchester County, in all things appertaining thereto, and shall well & truly account for all moneys placed in his hands for collection, and shall also well & truly pay all sums of Money received by him on Judgment or otherwise, then the above Obligation to be void, otherwise of full force & virtue in Law.
