The Condition of the above Obligation is such that if the above bounden George W. L. Smith shall well & truly execute the Office of Constable, of New Market district, in all things appertaining thereto, and shall also well & truly account for all monies placed in his hands for Collection, and shall also well & truly pay all sums of Money levied by him, on Judgment or otherwise, then the Obligation to be void, otherwise of full force & virtue in law.
