Thompson & Hutchinson } Know all men by these presents that we James Hutchinson & Mitchell Thompson, Executors of James Hutchinson, late of Dorchester County Md. deceased, for and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred and twenty five dollars, current money, to them in hand paid, by William Franklin Hicks, of the County & State aforesaid, have granted, bargained & sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain & sell, unto the said William Franklin Hicks, his heirs and assigns, one Negro Woman named Juliana, a servant unto the thirty first day of December, A. D. Eighteen hundred and fifty five, at which time the said Negro Juliana will be entitled to her freedom under the will of the said James Hutchinson decd. and of sound in body & mind - To have and to hold the said Negro Woman, as aforesaid, unto the expiration of the year Eighteen hundred & fifty five, as bargained & sold, unto the said William Franklin Hicks, his heirs, executors & Administrators: And the said James Hutchinson & Mitchell Thompson, Executors of the said James Hutchinson decd., do promise & agree to and with the said William Franklin Hicks, his heirs, executors and Administrators, the aforesaid bargained & sold Negro Woman, for the term above specified, against them, and against all and every person or persons whatsoever, shall & will hereafter warrant & former defend by these presents. In testimony whereof the said James Hutchinson & Mitchell Thompson, Executors as aforesaid, and William Franklin Hicks, (Purchaser,) have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals this twenty fifth day of May in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and fifty.
