hundred and fifty. The conditions of the above Obligations are such that
if the above bounden Wm Crighton shall well & truly discharge the duties of
Treasurer of the Primary Schools of Dorchester County according to law, then
the above obligation shall be void, otherwise it is to be & remain in full
force and virtue in law
