Sealed with our seals and dated this 9th day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty. The conditions of the above Obligations are such that if the above bounden Wm Crighton shall will & truly discharge the duties of Treasurer of the Primary Schools of Dorchester County according to law, then the above Obligation shall be void, otherwise it is to be & remain in full force and virtue in law
