Col. of Mills point, Dorchester County State of Maryland, of the other
part, Witnesseth, that the said Thomas C. Jones and John Jones of Col.
Executors as aforesaid, for and in consideration of the sum of one
hundred and ten dollars, current money of Maryland, to them in hand
paid by the said John Jones of Col. at and before the sealing and
delivering of these presents, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged,
heath granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents doth grant
bargain & sell unto the said John Jones of Col. his Executors, Admin-
istrators and assigns, one Negro Girl Mary, and belonging to the
Estate of the aforesaid Col. John Jones decd., for the full time
or term of Fourteen years from the twenty first day of March
Eighteen hundred and forty eight, that being the period of time
the said Mary has to serve, at the expiration of which time or term
