10-107. EXAMINATIONS — IN GENERAL.

(A) APPLICANT REQUIRED TO TAKE ONLY REQUESTED EXAMINATION.

AN APPLICANT MAY NOT BE REQUIRED TO TAKE AN EXAMINATION THAT RELATES TO ANY KIND OF INSURANCE OTHER THAN AS REQUESTED BY THE APPLICANT.

(B) MULTIPLE EXAMINATIONS IN SINGLE DAY.

IF THE APPLICANT REQUESTS, THE EXAMINATION SHALL BE ADMINISTERED TO ALLOW THE APPLICANT TO BE TESTED IN MORE THAN ONE KIND OF INSURANCE IN ONE DAY.

(C) APPLICATION FEE.

AN APPLICANT FOR AN EXAMINATION SPECIFIED IN THIS SUBTITLE SHALL PAY THE APPLICATION FEE REQUIRED BY § 2-112 OF THIS ARTICLE.

10-108. SAME — INSURANCE OTHER THAN LIFE AND HEALTH INSURANCE AND ANNUITIES.

(A) RIGHT TO EXAMINATION.

AN APPLICANT WHO OTHERWISE QUALIFIES FOR A CERTIFICATE OF QUALIFICATION FOR INSURANCE OTHER THAN LIFE INSURANCE, HEALTH INSURANCE, ANNUITIES, OR LIMITED LINES IS ENTITLED TO BE EXAMINED AS PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION.

(B) TIME AND PLACE OF EXAMINATION.

THE COMMISSIONER SHALL GIVE EXAMINATIONS TO APPLICANTS AT LEAST ONCE EVERY 30 DAYS AT THE TIMES AND PLACES THAT THE COMMISSIONER DETERMINES.

(C) EXAMINATION FEE.

AN APPLICANT SHALL PAY TO THE COMMISSIONER A FEE OF \$15 FOR EACH EXAMINATION.

(D) SUBJECTS AND METHOD OF EXAMINATION.
