

TO DETERMINE THE COMPETENCE OF THE APPLICANT AS TO THE KIND OR SUBDIVISION OF INSURANCE FOR WHICH THE APPLICANT WANTS TO BECOME QUALIFIED, THE APPLICANT SHALL PASS A WRITTEN EXAMINATION THAT RELATES TO THAT KIND OR SUBDIVISION OF INSURANCE.

(E) RETAKING EXAMINATION.

(1) AN APPLICANT WHO FAILS AN EXAMINATION MAY NOT TAKE ANOTHER EXAMINATION UNTIL AT LEAST 14 DAYS AFTER THE DATE OF THE LAST EXAMINATION THAT THE APPLICANT FAILED.

(2) AN APPLICANT WHO FAILS AN EXAMINATION THREE TIMES MAY NOT APPLY TO TAKE AN EXAMINATION AGAIN FOR AT LEAST 3 MONTHS AFTER THE DATE OF THE LAST EXAMINATION THAT THE APPLICANT FAILED.

(3) AN APPLICANT WHO FAILS AN EXAMINATION SIX TIMES MAY NOT APPLY TO TAKE AN EXAMINATION AGAIN FOR AT LEAST 1 YEAR AFTER THE DATE OF THE LAST EXAMINATION THAT THE APPLICANT FAILED.

10-109. SAME — LIFE AND HEALTH INSURANCE AND ANNUITIES:

(A) RIGHT TO EXAMINATION.

AN APPLICANT WHO OTHERWISE QUALIFIES FOR A CERTIFICATE OF QUALIFICATION FOR LIFE INSURANCE, HEALTH INSURANCE, ANNUITIES, NONPROFIT HEALTH SERVICE PLANS, DENTAL PLAN ORGANIZATIONS, OR HEALTH MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATIONS IS ENTITLED TO BE EXAMINED AS PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION.

(B) TIME AND PLACE OF EXAMINATION.
