

(1) SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE COMMISSIONER SHALL GIVE EXAMINATIONS TO APPLICANTS AT LEAST ONCE EVERY 2 WEEKS AT THE TIMES AND PLACES THAT THE COMMISSIONER DETERMINES.

(2) THE COMMISSIONER SHALL OFFER THE EXAMINATIONS:

(I) AT LEAST ONCE A MONTH AT A PLACE THAT THE COMMISSIONER DETERMINES ON THE EASTERN SHORE OF THE STATE; AND

(II) AT LEAST ONCE A MONTH AT A PLACE THAT THE COMMISSIONER DETERMINES ON THE WESTERN SHORE OF THE STATE, OTHER THAN BALTIMORE CITY.

(C) CERTIFICATE OF COMPLETION.

TO TAKE AN EXAMINATION, AN APPLICANT SHALL SUBMIT TO THE COMMISSIONER A CERTIFICATE OF COMPLETION SHOWING THAT THE APPLICANT HAS MET THE EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS OF § 10-105(C) OF THIS SUBTITLE.

(D) SUBJECTS AND METHOD OF EXAMINATION.

(1) EACH APPLICANT MUST PASS A PERSONAL WRITTEN EXAMINATION TO DETERMINE:

(I) THE COMPETENCE OF THE APPLICANT AS TO LIFE INSURANCE, HEALTH INSURANCE, OR ANNUITIES OR TO ANY SUBDIVISION OF THEM, INCLUDING CONTRACTS FOR NONPROFIT HEALTH SERVICE PLANS, VISION PLANS, DENTAL PLAN ORGANIZATIONS, AND HEALTH MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATIONS; AND

(II) THE FAMILIARITY OF THE APPLICANT WITH THE APPLICABLE LAWS OF THE STATE.

(2) EACH EXAMINATION MUST BE GRADED WITHIN 30 DAYS AFTER THE DATE OF THE EXAMINATION.

(E) RETAKING EXAMINATION.

AN APPLICANT WHO FAILS AN EXAMINATION MAY NOT TAKE ANOTHER EXAMINATION UNTIL AT LEAST 14 DAYS AFTER THE DATE OF THE LAST EXAMINATION THAT THE APPLICANT FAILED.

(F) REGULATIONS.

THE COMMISSIONER SHALL ADOPT REASONABLE REGULATIONS ABOUT:

(1) THE SCOPE, TYPE, CONDUCT, AND GRADING OF THE WRITTEN EXAMINATIONS; AND

(2) THE TIMES AND PLACES IN THE STATE WHERE THE EXAMINATIONS SHALL BE HELD.
