- (A) Technology Advancement Program. Construct a replacement facility for the Technology Advancement Program at the University of Maryland College Park, provided, however, that upon completion, no incubator space for an emerging technology or business shall be utilized or contracted for, until and unless, the entity seeking such space agrees in writing to reimburse the University twice the costs associated with space use and rental should that entity leave the State of Maryland within five years of being a tenant in this incubator to pursue expansion, production or manufacturing relative to the technology which the incubator space facilitated in development. Reimbursement shall apply only if 40% or more of the company's employment is transferred outside Maryland. Full reimbursement will apply to companies that leave the State of Maryland during the first two years after graduating from the incubator and shall be applied on a scale which declines to zero on the fifth anniversary of graduation.
