(a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section or otherwise by law, all employees of the College are in the classified service of the State Personnel Management System.

(b) All officers, faculty, and administrative employees of the College are in the unclassified service of the State Personnel Management System.

(a) (4) "Program" means the Maryland [Vending Facilities] BUSINESS ENTERPRISE Program for the Blind.

(b) There is a Maryland [Vending Facilities] BUSINESS ENTERPRISE Program for the Blind in the Division.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the amount of annual leave to which an employee is entitled for the period of time from the date of employment with the State to the effective date of this Act shall be recomputed to take into account the employee's years of service with Baltimore City, as required by this Act. Any additional annual leave to which an employee is entitled based on the recomputation shall be credited to the employee in two increments, 50% on July 1, 1995, and 50% on January
