DRAFTER'S NOTE:

Subsection (e) of this section is amended to reflect that it applies to employees of the Department of State Police. Before enactment of Chs. 165 and 166, Acts of 1994, employees of the State Police were included in the reference to employees of the Department of Public Safety and Correctional Services since the State Police were part of that department. Chapters 165 and 166, Acts of 1994, however, made the State Police a separate department so a separate reference to the Department of State Police must be added for subsection (e) to continue to apply to employees of the Department of State Police.
