

- (i) the Secretary of Budget and Fiscal Planning;
- (ii) the Secretary of State; and
- (iii) the Director of Planning;

(4) a representative of the Maryland Association of Counties, appointed by the president of the association; and

(5) a representative of the Maryland Municipal League, appointed by the president of the league.

(b) (1) The terms of the representatives of the Maryland Association of Counties and the Maryland Municipal League are 4 years.

(2) At the end of a term, a representative member continues to serve until a successor is appointed and qualifies.

(3) A representative member who is appointed after a term has begun serves only for the remainder of the term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.]

The Commission shall meet from time to time to consider issues of concern to the Committee.]

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1995.

Dear Mr. President:

In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed Senate Bill 738.

This bill makes knowingly and willfully taking a motor vehicle from the custody, control, or use of the owner without the owner's consent punishable by a fine up to \$5,000 and/or five years imprisonment.

House Bill 497, which was passed by the General Assembly and signed by me on May 9, 1995, accomplishes the same purpose. Therefore, it is not necessary for me to sign Senate Bill 738.
