SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- (E-2) IN BALTIMORE CITY, THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS SHALL:
- (1) EMPLOY A QUALIFIED ATTORNEY TO SERVE AS APPELLATE COUNSEL FOR THE BOARD IN ACTIONS OF APPEAL; AND
- (2) SET THE ANNUAL SALARY FOR THE APPELLATE COUNSEL AT NOT LESS THAN \$16,000 FOR APPELLATE COUNSEL THE SAME COMPENSATION AND BENEFITS AS ARE SET FOR FULL-TIME INSPECTORS.
