(II) ONE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE MARYLAND CHAMBER OF COMMERCE;

(III) ONE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE GREATER BALTIMORE COMMITTEE;

(IV) ONE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE WASHINGTON BOARD OF TRADE;

(V) ONE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE MARYLAND ASSOCIATION OF COUNTIES;

(VI) ONE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE MARYLAND MUNICIPAL LEAGUE;

(VII) ONE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE MARYLAND ASSOCIATION OF UNITED WAYS;

(VIII) TWO REPRESENTATIVES OF OTHER BUSINESS ORGANIZATIONS SELECTED BY THE GOVERNOR; AND

(IX) ~~EIGHT ADDITIONAL MEMBERS, REPRESENTING OTHER NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS OR FOUNDATIONS FROM AROUND THE STATE, SELECTED IN CONSULTATION WITH THE MARYLAND ASSOCIATION OF NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS~~ SEVEN MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC.

(C) THE GOVERNOR SHALL:

(1) DESIGNATE A CHAIRMAN OF THE TASK FORCE; AND

(2) ASSIGN PERSONNEL TO SERVE AS STAFF TO THE TASK FORCE.
