- (1) ONE MEMBER OF THE SENATE OF MARYLAND, APPOINTED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE;
- (2) ONE MEMBER OF THE HOUSE OF DELEGATES, APPOINTED BY THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE; AND
 - (3) THE SECRETARY OF STATE; AND
- (3) SEVENTEEN (4) SIXTEEN MEMBERS APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR, AS FOLLOWS:
- (I) ONE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE MARYLAND ASSOCIATION OF NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS;
- (II) ONE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE MARYLAND CHAMBER OF COMMERCE;
- (III) ONE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE GREATER BALTIMORE COMMITTEE;
- (IV) ONE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE WASHINGTON BOARD OF TRADE;
- (V) ONE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE MARYLAND ASSOCIATION OF COUNTIES;
- (VI) ONE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE MARYLAND MUNICIPAL LEAGUE;
- (VII) ONE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE MARYLAND ASSOCIATION OF UNITED WAYS;

(VIII) TWO REPRESENTATIVES OF OTHER BUSINESS ORGANIZATIONS SELECTED BY THE GOVERNOR; AND

- (IX) EIGHT ADDITIONAL MEMBERS, REPRESENTING OTHER NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS OR FOUNDATIONS FROM AROUND THE STATE, SELECTED IN CONSULTATION WITH THE MARYLAND ASSOCIATION OF NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS SEVEN MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC.
 - (C) THE GOVERNOR SHALL:
 - (1) DESIGNATE A CHAIRMAN OF THE TASK FORCE; AND
 - (2) ASSIGN PERSONNEL TO SERVE AS STAFF TO THE TASK FORCE.
- (D) (1) THE MISSION OF THE TASK FORCE IS THE DEVELOPMENT OF A STRATEGY TO DOUBLE INCREASE THE AMOUNT OF CHARITABLE GIVING BY INDIVIDUALS AND CORPORATIONS IN MARYLAND WITHIN 5 YEARS.
 - (2) THE TASK FORCE SHALL:
