SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Education

16-402.

- (A) The Board of Community College Trustees for Baltimore County consists of [11] 15 members appointed by the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Senate.
 - (B) Of the members:
 - (1) [4 serve] 1 SERVES at large; and
- (2) [7] 14 serve from the 7 councilmanic districts in Baltimore County, [1] 2 from each district.
 - (C) (1) THE TERM OF A MEMBER IS 5 YEARS AND BEGINS ON JULY 1.
- (2) A MEMBER MAY NOT SERVE FOR MORE THAN 2 CONSECUTIVE TERMS.
- (D) (1) THE GOVERNOR SHALL APPOINT A CHAIRPERSON FROM AMONG THE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD AS OF JULY 1, 1997.
- (2) THE CHAIRPERSON APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR SHALL SERVE UNTIL JUNE 30, 2000.
- (3) FOR THE YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 2000 AND EACH YEAR THEREAFTER, THE BOARD SHALL ELECT A CHAIRPERSON FROM AMONG THE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That an individual who is a member of the Board of Community College Trustees for Baltimore County on the effective date of this Act:

- (1) may serve the remainder of the individual's term; and
- (2) is eligible to be appointed to 1 additional term.
