SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Article 27 - Crimes and Punishments

561A.

- (a) (1) In this section the following words have the meanings indicated.
- (2) (4) "LOCAL OFFICIAL" MEANS AN ELECTED OFFICER INDIVIDUAL SERVING IN A PUBLICLY ELECTED OFFICE OF A LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT, AS DEFINED IN  $\S$  10–101(D) OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE.
- (II) "LOCAL OFFICIAL" INCLUDES AN ELECTED OFFICIAL OF AN OFFICE, BOARD OR DEPARTMENT THAT IS ESTABLISHED IN A COUNTY UNDER STATE LAW OR PUBLIC LOCAL LAW.
- [(2)](3) (i) "State official" means a State official as defined in § 15–102 of the State Government Article.
- (ii) "State official" includes the Governor, Governor-elect, Lieutenant Governor, and Lieutenant Governor-elect.
  - [(3)](4) "Threat" includes:
    - (i) A verbal threat; or
