- (2) The disposition of abandoned vehicles;
- (3) The rights and obligations of property owners who have vehicles towed
- from their property;
- (4) The rights of individuals whose vehicles are towed without their consent;
- (5) The imposition of liens on motor vehicles, including the scope of a lien
