(Senate Bill 734)

AN ACT concerning

Scrap Tire Disposal – Fee and Reimbursements Use of Fund – Fee Termination

FOR the purpose of ~~altering the limit of the State Used Tire Cleanup and Recycling Fund; establishing a certain limitation on the use of certain funds reimbursed to the State Used Tire Cleanup and Recycling Fund~~ altering the permissible use of the State Used Tire Cleanup and Recycling Fund to include certain emergency operations; eliminating a certain tire recycling fee ~~and a certain limitation on local government~~ after a certain date; requesting the Board of Public Works to decrease the tire recycling fee ~~during certain fiscal years~~; providing for the delayed effective date of a portion of this Act; and generally relating to scrap tires and disposal.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
