- (7) one representative of nonprofit health service plans;
- (8) one representative of domestic mutual insurers;
- (9) one representative of domestic stock insurers;
- (10) one representative of insurance professionals; and
- (11) one member of the general public.
- (d) The Insurance Commissioner shall serve as Chairman of the Advisory Committee.
- (e) A member of the Advisory Committee may not receive compensation but is entitled to reimbursement for expenses under the Standard State Travel Regulations, as provided in the State budget.
- (f) The Insurance Administration shall provide staffing services for the Advisory Committee.
- (g) On or before November 1, 1997, the Advisory Committee shall submit a report to the Governor and, subject to § 2–1312 of the State Government Article, to the General Assembly on the results of its study, including any legislative proposals and recommendations.
- SECTION 4. 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 1 of except as provided in Sections 6 and 7 of this Act, this Act shall take effect June July 1, 1997.
- SECTION 5. 6 AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 2 Section 3 of this Act shall take effect October 1, 1997. Section 3 of this Act shall remain effective for 9 months and, at the end of June 30, 1998, with no further action required by the General Assembly, Section 3 of this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.

SECTION 6. Z. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 3. Section 4 of this Act shall take effect January 1, 2002. June 1, 1997.
